## Why do we have a Code of Conduct?

### The Code of Conduct

By purchasing a ticket to one of our events, you agree to adhere to the following principals, and will take responsibility for your own behaviour during the event.

#### You will:

- be welcoming, supportive and kind to others
- be respectful of those around you
- be open, honest, and clear with your dice, rules, and measurements during your games
- report any breaches of this code to the event organisers/volunteers
- have fun!

## You will not:

- behave in a way that could be considered intimidating or threatening
- be abusive towards or bully other people
- let others behaviour which breaches this Code of Conduct go unreported

## What happens if I do not follow the Code of Conduct?

## Minor and first-time incident:

- One of our team will politely remind you of the Code of Conduct and ask you to change your behaviour.
- Gaming infractions may result in you receiving a 'yellow card' which could include a points/win deduction and may affect your ability to purchase tickets to future Saffron Slam events, and/or events which recognise cards issued at the Saffron Slam.

## Serious or second-time incidents:

- You will be asked to leave the event.
- Gaming infractions may result in your receiving a 'red card' which will include immediate disqualification from the event and will affect your ability to purchase tickets to future Saffron Slam events, and/or events which recognise cards issued at the Saffron Slam.
